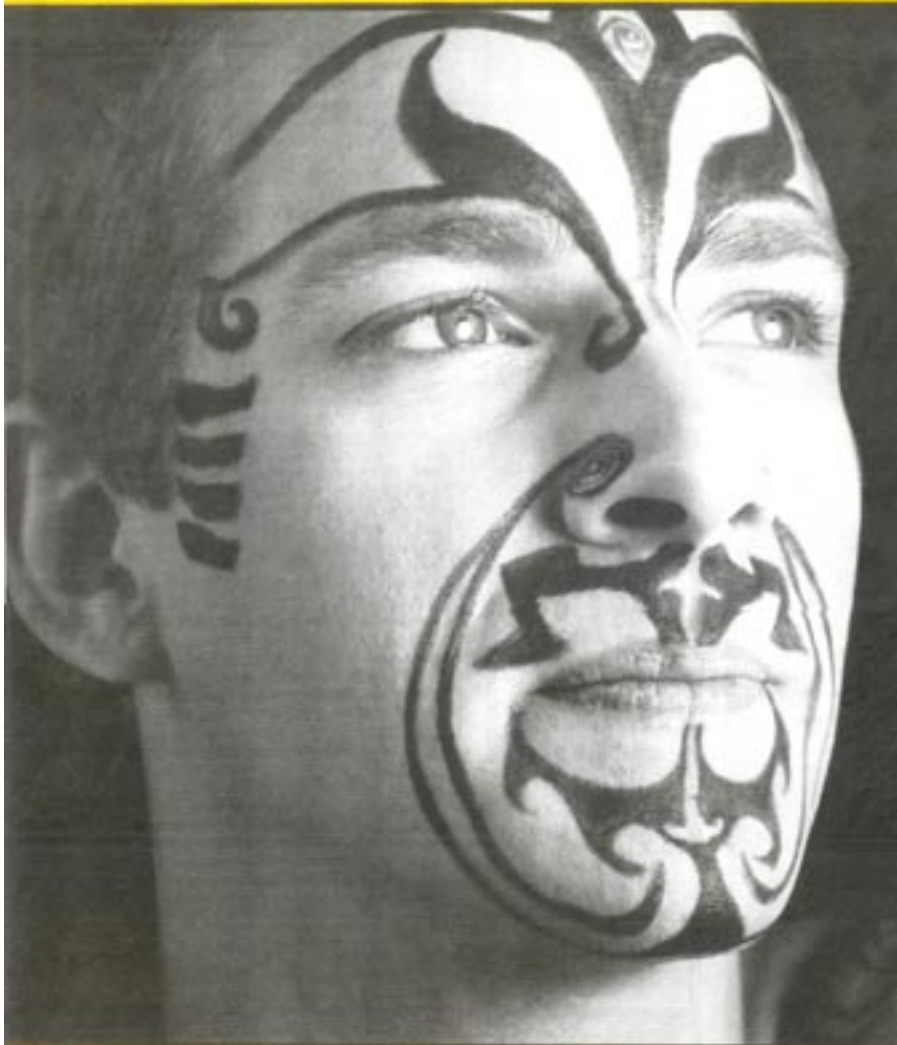

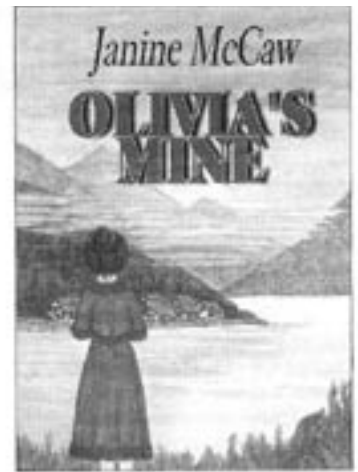

Olivia's Mine is a fictional account of a young bride's struggle to make a life for herself against the backdrop of the disasters that hit Britannia Beach, British Columbia in the early 1900s. Based on real life events, Olivia's Mine follows the adventures of young newlywed Olivia Fitzpatrick as she leaves her affluent Seattle family to join her husband Frank in the isolated and tight-knit seaside mining community of Britannia Beach. Olivia has always gone against the grain with her choices in life, but as she boards a vessel bound for a foreign country she has never visited, she knows her life is about to change forever. In spite of catastrophes, flu epidemics, and the chaos of World War I, Olivia is determined to continue her life in Britannia Beach.

Olivia's Mine marks Vancouver-based novelist Janine McCaw's debut as a popular fiction writer. McCaw's deep understanding of compelling plots, widely appealing characters, natural dialogue and strong story arcs comes directly out of her early career in the film and television industry. ■
